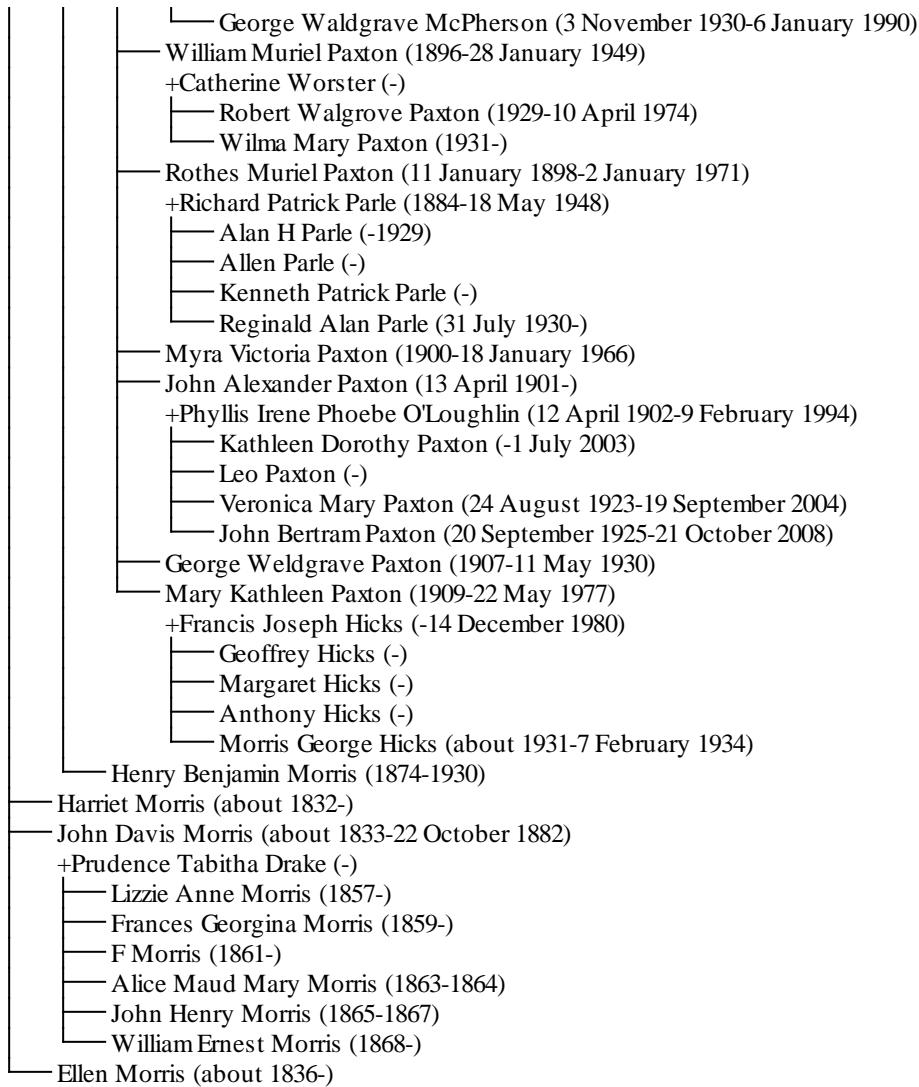

1. **John Davis Morris** was born about 1783 in Feckenham, Worcestershire, England.<sup>1-2</sup> On June 6, 1841 he was a farmer in Feckenham, Worcestershire, England.<sup>3</sup> On March 30, 1851 he was a farmer, with 18 acres of land in Feckenham, Worcestershire, England.<sup>1</sup> On April 7, 1861 John was a retired farmer in Feckenham, Worcestershire, England.<sup>2</sup>

John Davis Morris and Ann Elizabeth Sheward<sup>1-5</sup> were married on May 6, 1827 at St. Helens in Worcester, Worcestershire, England.<sup>4</sup> They appeared in the census on June 6, 1841 in Feckenham, Worcestershire, England.<sup>3</sup> They appeared in the census on March 30, 1851 in Feckenham, Worcestershire, England.<sup>1</sup> John and Ann appeared in the census on April 7, 1861 at Moors Lane in Feckenham, Worcestershire, England.<sup>2</sup> **Ann Elizabeth Sheward** was born about 1796 in Dillwin, Herefordshire, England.

## First Generation

1. **William James Morris**<sup>1</sup> was born in 1830 in Feckenham, Worcestershire, England.<sup>2-3</sup> He was christened on December 2, 1830 in Feckenham, Worcestershire, England.<sup>3</sup> He appeared in the census in the household of John Davis Morris and Ann Elizabeth Sheward on June 6, 1841 in Feckenham, Worcestershire, England.<sup>2</sup> William appeared in the census in the household of John Davis Morris and Ann Elizabeth Sheward on March 30, 1851 in Feckenham, Worcestershire, England.<sup>4</sup> He immigrated on August 15, 1855 to Sydney, New South Wales, Australia.<sup>5</sup> William, Clara, along with their 2 children Elizabeth and John arrived via the "Startled Fawn" which left the port of Liverpool, UK. In 1871 he was a gold miner at Jembaicumbene in Braidwood, New South Wales, Australia.<sup>6</sup> William died on October 4, 1895 at the age of 65 in Braidwood, New South Wales, Australia.<sup>7</sup>

William James Morris and Clarinda Lea were married on September 30, 1852 at All Saints in Birmingham, Warwickshire, England.<sup>8</sup> **Clarinda Lea**, daughter of John Lea and Sarah Hardridge, was born on April 19, 1830 in Feckenham, Worcestershire, England. In 1851 she was a needle maker at Nest in Alcester, Warwickshire, England. She immigrated on August 15, 1855 to Sydney, New South Wales, Australia.<sup>5</sup> Clarinda died on May 6, 1907 at the age of 77 at Little River in Braidwood, New South Wales, Australia.<sup>9</sup> She was buried on May 8, 1907 in Braidwood, New South Wales, Australia. On May 8, 1907, the following article was written about her:<sup>1</sup> The Funeral of Mrs. Morris, who died on Monday, at the residence of her daughter, Mrs. M Malone, 'The Gardens' and who was reported to have died on Friday last, will take place this afternoon. She leaves a family of four sons and three daughters, viz., Messrs. Patrick Reuben, Edward, Walter and Henry, and daughters are Mesdames Malone, Bracken and Paxton. The deceased lady was 77 years of age. She and her late husband, who died some 11 years since and was employed at the Braidwood Flour Mills, came to New South Wales from Birmingham 51 years ago, having two children at the time. Her husband came out under engagement to the late Dr. Moreing in connection with a mining undertaking, he being an engineer. During their long residence in Braidwood the late Mrs. Morris and her deceased husband were highly respected. The Braidwood dispatch - 8th May 1907

- +7 vi. **Patrick Reuben Morris**, born 1864, Braidwood, New South Wales, Australia; married Catherine Hennessy, 1894, Woollahra, New South Wales, Australia; died February 26, 1928, Chatswood, New South Wales, Australia.

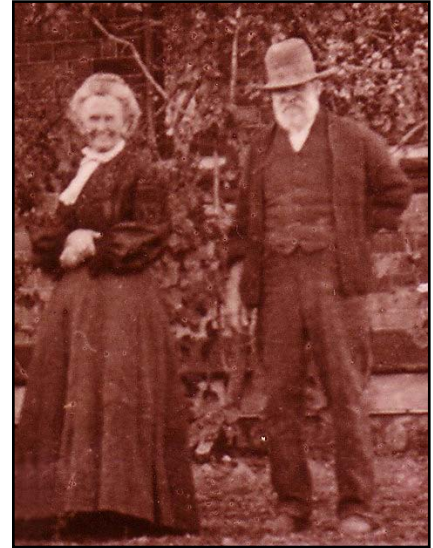


*Headstone for William & Clarinda Morris

## Second Generation

2. **Elizabeth Ann Morris** was christened on December 25, 1853 in Feckenham, Worcestershire, England.<sup>19</sup> She immigrated on August 15, 1855 to Sydney, New South Wales, Australia.<sup>5</sup> She died on December 25, 1917 in Ryde, New South Wales, Australia.<sup>20-21</sup> Elizabeth was buried after December 25, 1917 at North Rocks cemetery in Sydney, New South Wales, Australia.<sup>20</sup>

Phyllis was recorded as performing home duties. He lived at Palmerston Road in Fairfield, New South Wales, Australia in 1936.<sup>67</sup> According to the electoral roll, he was registered as a plumber. It appears by this time, John and Phyllis had separated. He was rumored to have died in South Australia, but there is no trace on the S.A. registries 1920-1970 for John Alexander Paxton. I have not been able to find any subsequent traces of John Paxton at this point.

It's not clear why this information was given at the time of registration - a possibility is due to the fact that Bert and Phyllis were not married at the time and very young. She lived at 7 Lord Street in North Sydney, New South Wales, Australia on May 7, 1920.<sup>87</sup> She

died on February 9, 1994 at the age of 91 at Elizabeth Drive Nursing Home in Camden, New South Wales, Australia. Phyllis was cremated on February 14, 1994 in Leppington, New South Wales, Australia. She was also known as Phyllis Irene Phoebe Paxton.<sup>137</sup> She was also known as Phyllis Irene Phoebe Evans.
